Instructions to Candidates

- 1 This is a hands-on assessment which should be completed by June 2018 before theory examinations start.
- 2 Candidates sitting for Fashion and Fabrics in 2018 should collect this project paper upon registration.
- 3 Candidates are required to design and make two garments:
 - (i) One to fit the candidate;
 - (ii) One for a 3 year old child.
- 4 A portfolio of all the processes should be included to show the methods used from the beginning to the end.
- 5 Throughout the period, all candidates are expected to work in consultation with a Fashion and Fabrics teacher at an examination centre close to them.
- 6 The finished articles together with the portfolios should be well packed and clearly labelled for submission to the Provincial Education Officer on the same day with Fashion and Fabrics paper 2.

- Question:** (a) Design and make a personal outfit for yourself, include accessories.
 (b) Design and make a pair of shorts for a three year old boy with a patch pocket and an elastic on the back.

Below is the assessment criterion.

Assessment criteria	Examples	Marks
Process file for the personal attire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Choice of fabric – layout – processes of joining and neatening 	5 marks
Choice of style	Choice of style in relation to the age, figure type, fabric and colour.	2 marks
Processes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Joining stitches – Neatening stitches – Seam allowance – Type of seams (suitable for the garments) 	6 marks
Edge finishes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Correct width – Hem – Facing – Yoke – Collar – Attaching pocket 	8 marks
Disposal of fullness (suitable for the age and garment)	Suitable for the type of style e.g. pleats, darts, pin tucks, etc.	6 marks
Opening and fastening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Zips – Button and button hole 	5 marks
Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Bangles – Bags – Earrings – Belts – Necklaces, etc. 	5 marks
Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Pressing of garments – Folding – Labelling of garments (no pins) – Labelling placed on single fabric – no pin – No left over fabric should be packed 	3 marks
