Processes	Stitches, seams, control of fullness, openings, collars, pockets, sleeves, cuffs and yokes.	25 marks
Decoration of garments	Use of decorative stitches, lace, ribbons and trimmings.	5 marks
Presentation	Pressing of garments, neatness and trimmings, name tag, appropriate packaging etc.	3
