TASK 1**

RAIL TRANSPORT

The first railway lines in Cameroon were constructed by the Germans to evacuate produce from the hinterland to the port of Douala, and imported goods from there into the hinterlands. The first line, from Bonaberi to Nkongsamba, “Kamerun Nord Bahn” was begun in nineteen zero six and commissioned on first April nineteen eleven. This was followed by the Douala-Yaounde line started in nineteen ten. It had to cease at Eseka (one hundred and seventy three point six kilometres) from Douala when the first World War broke out. The line was later completed by the French between nineteen twenty-two and nineteen twenty-seven.

After independence, the Cameroon government began work on the Trans-Cameroon line on the thirty-first October nineteen sixty-four. This line which had also been projected by the Germans was commissioned on the eighth April, nineteen sixty nine. Another branch had also been constructed to link this main line called Trans-Cameroon, which extended from Yaounde to Balabo in the Eastern Province. As of nineteen eighty, the railway network was one thousand one hundred and forty three kilometres of metric meters, mainly single track. However, this distance would be shorter when the reconstruction work on the Douala-Yaounde section is completed. The railway’s northern line terminus is at Ngaoundere.

The management and the use of this network is in the hands of the National Railway Corporation. Bulky goods such as timber, petrol, iron rods, cows among others are transported by train, thus easing the congestion on roads and disenclaving parts of the country. The railway corporation also runs a passage service alongside its cargo service which is a very popular means of travelling.

The railway corporation serves the public by providing a passenger service and by disenclaving areas of the country, which would otherwise be inaccessible, like parts of Bassaland. The service it provides to business is in the carriage of goods on cargo trains. These trains include containers and open wagons for cows and rods among others. It also provides branchings for certain firms in Douala and Edea for example, Cimencam and Socame in Bonaberi-Douala, and Alucam in Edea.
