c) State the two (2) proverbs Jesus used to them. (4marks)
d) 'They lack understanding in the proverbs' (1 Kgs. 17: 8-16 and 2 Kgs 5: 1-14).
Examine the two (2) Old Testament texts Jesus used to clarify them. (4.5x2 marks)

4. a) What is a miracle? (4marks)
b) Name the four (4) types of Miracles. (4marks)
c) Using two (2) types named in 4b, illustrate how the miracles of Jesus differ from ours today. (17marks)

5. 'The main opposing groups or parties during Jesus' time were the Pharisees and the Sadducees.'
a) How and why? Illustrate with four (4) cases (3x4marks)
b) Who were the Pharisees and Sadducees? (6marks)
c) Of what relevance are the opposing groups to our society today? (7marks)

6. The death of Jesus was willed by God and accepted by him. Do you agree? (25marks)

10. Jesus was worried about the unity amongst his followers.

a) Discuss the importance of the unity amongst brethren working together for a common goal. (15marks)

b) What factors hinder the unity amongst Christians today? (10marks)

11. a) What are the leadership exercises Jesus does in the Gospel according to John? (10marks)

b) "I am the vine and you are the branches". Analyze and contextualize this statement bringing out the advantages. (15marks)

12. Jesus prayed for himself, for his disciples and for all believers.

a) Bring out the prayer said in each case. (15marks)

b) What is the importance of the prayer he prayed? (10marks)

13. The Acts of the apostles are the acts of the Holy Spirit. Discuss. (25marks)

14. Discuss the role played by women in the growth of the early church (25marks)

15. a) Discuss the difference between Peter and Paul in their apostolic roles in the early church. (13marks)

b) Explain the areas of their disagreement (12marks)

16. "Paul is a favoured opportunist". How true is this statement in his life and works in church growth? (25marks)

17. Marriage scandals of sexual immorality, and divisions and factions in the church were two prominent problems in the Corinthian Church. Analyze the problems and show how Paul addressed them. (25marks)

18. Explain the gifts of the Holy Spirit as highlighted in Paul's first letter to the Corinthians (25marks)

19. Asses the importance of First Hejira and the capture of Mecca to the expansion of Islam. (25marks)

20. Discuss the roles played by the four (4) caliphs in the establishment of Islam. (25marks)

21. Examine the assertion that the Pillars of Islam are contributors to the growth of Islam. (25marks)

22. a) Comment on the claim that "Islam is a religion of peace" (9marks)
b) What role do the jihads play in the expansion of Islam? (16marks)

23. Differentiate between any three groups of sects in Islam, tracing their origin. (25marks)

24. a) How did pre-Islam Arabia necessitate the coming of Islam? (13marks)
b) The beginning of the Qur'an is the beginning of Islam. Discuss(12marks)
