2. Under what circumstances and with what effects was Islam introduced in North Cameroon during the 19th century? (25 marks)

3. "European interests along the coast of Cameroon were purely economic." How true is this assertion? (25 marks)

4. Account for the outbreak and failure of indigenous resistance against German administration in Cameroon between 1884 and 1914. (25 marks)

SECTION B: 1922 – 1961

5. Why and with what consequences was British Southern Cameroons administered as part of Eastern Nigeria? (25 marks)

6. To what extent did the French colonial administration adhere to the terms of the Trusteeship Agreement in French Cameroon after 1945? (25marks)

7. Was the creation of the KNDP in 1955 by JN Foncha a blessing or curse in the independence struggle in British Southern Cameroons? (25 marks)

8. Examine the successes and failures of the UPC in achieving its aims in French Cameroon between 1951 and 1960. (25 marks)

SECTION C: 1961 TO PRESENT

9. Account for the weak bargaining strength of the Southern Cameroons' delegation at the 1961 Founban constitutional conference. (25 marks)

10. Discuss the social and economic changes introduced by the government of AN Jua in West Cameroon between 1965 and 1968. (25 marks)

11. Why and with what effects did Cameroon adopt a single party system in 1966? (25 marks)

12. Examine the reasons for the discontent among some Cameroonians during the early administration of Paul Biya as President and discuss the measures adopted to redress the situation? (25 marks)
