3. Carefully examine the demerits of the colonial policies of Indirect Rule and Assimilation in West Africa. (25 marks)

4. Account for the rapid growth of African nationalism after 1945. (25 marks)

5. For what reasons and with what results did the military intervene in the politics of Uganda in 1971? (25 marks)

6. Assess the impact of the growing refugee crisis in Africa since 1960. (25 marks)

SECTION C: WORLD REVOLUTIONS AND DIPLOMACY, 1700-1919

7. Discuss the view that "the 1688 revolution in England was glorious and inglorious." (25 marks)

8. Examine the role of British economic and political policies in the outbreak of the American War of Independence in 1776. (25 marks)

9. How far did militarism and the Alliance System contribute to the outbreak of the First World War in 1914. (25 marks)

SECTION D: WORLD, 1919 TO THE PRESENT DATE

10. What attempts were made to achieve Collective Security in the 1920s and why did it fail in the 1930s? (25 marks)

11. Analyse the causes and consequences of the Cold War after 1945. (25 marks)

12. To what extent has the Commonwealth of Nations achieved its objectives? (25 marks)
